7. § Financial review

Presenter: Sauli Sarjus

Presentation: By the end of the financial year on December 31, 2023, the Student Union's surplus was €7,639.39, whereas in 2022, the financial year resulted in a deficit of €17,249.87. However, it should be noted that there may still be changes to the financial result and the income statement.

Attached (Appendix 1) is the income statement for the year 2023. Membership fee income for 2023 amounted to €145,139.13. During 2023, Kaakko paid membership fees totaling €22,294.00. This sum consists essentially entirely of membership fees paid to SAMOK. The amount of fees paid in 2023 increased compared to 2022, thanks to an active board. Conversely, the amount spent on purchased services decreased, especially due to the absence of the Executive Director (due to trust positions). The costs of the Savonlinna Student Culture Development Project were €57,966.69 in 2023.

There is currently no information available on the Student Union's investments.
